

Test Day: What to Expect

The GED consists of the following five sub-tests:

Writing~~~~~	2 Hours
Social Studies~~~~~	1 Hour, 10 Minutes
Science~~~~~	1 Hour, 20 Minutes
Literature~~~~~	1 Hour, 5 Minutes
Math, Part 1~~~~~	45 Minutes
Math, Part 2~~~~~	45 Minutes

It is extremely important to arrive at your assigned time, which is 4:45PM.

Upon entering Central Nine, report to the vending machine area (Commons), where attendance will be taken and someone will direct you to the testing room.

You must have the receipt and same picture ID with you that you presented when you signed up to take the test.

Pens, pencils and paper are furnished. Calculators are furnished for Math, Part 1.

A scheduled break will be taken as a group.

There are vending machines in the Commons area for your use. Food and drink are not allowed in the testing room.

Cell phones are **NOT** allowed in the testing area.

The General Educational Development (GED) tests can give you the opportunity to earn a high school equivalency diploma - a credential recognized as a key to employment opportunities, advancement, further education, and financial rewards.

Although you must be at least **16** years of age to take the GED test, you are never too old to test. Applicants are required to be residents of the State of Indiana at least 30 days prior to taking the test. Everyone must register in advance and in person during regular office hours.

If you under 18 years of age, you must:

- ❖ Present an exit interview form from the last high school you attended. This form must be signed by you, your parent or guardian, and school principal and the school superintendent.
- ❖ Present three pieces of identification, one **must** be a picture ID, INDIANA driver's license or INDIANA State identification card
- ❖ Prepay \$70 in cash, the correct change

If you are **18** years of age or older, you must:

- ❖ Present three pieces of identification, one **must** be a picture ID, INDIANA driver's license or INDIANA State identification card
- ❖ Prepay \$70 in cash, the correct change

Monday -Thursday, 9 am to 6 pm: Friday., 9:30 am to 4 pm. Central Nine Career Center is located at 1999 US 31 South, Greenwood, 4 miles south of the Greenwood Park Mall. The following is required at registration:

You must register PRIOR to test date.

We are unable to reserve test space without payment and proper ID.

Home Schooled Student

If you have been home schooled, you must:

- ❖ Meet the requirements already outlined for 17 year olds.
- ❖ The exit interview process, the parent or guardian of a home-schooled individual may sign the exit interview form as both parent and principal. However you will need a superintendent from that school district to also sign.

Out of State Student

If you have attended high school out of state, you must:

- ❖ Have the exit interview form completed and obtain documents from your out of state high school

Vouchers

Central Nine will accept vouchers from Indiana Department of Workforce Development (employment & training offices).

Transcripts and Duplicate Certificates

To obtain a copy of your GED transcript or diploma, you must access

register as a former test taker and request your documents from this site. There is a charge for duplications.

Scoring/Results/Retesting

Typically, you will receive your results in the mail **2-4 weeks** after testing. If you pass the test, you will receive a certificate and a report of your scores.

If you do not pass the test, you will have the opportunity to retest. You can test up to three times per year. We offer one retesting date / month.

You will be charged \$15.00 for each sub-test you retake. Please be sure you understand the scoring requirements that are explained on your report. You must score at least a 410 on each sub-test and an overall average of at least 450 to pass.

GED Classes

GED classes are optional and available for individuals 16 or older who wish to prepare for the GED test in a classroom environment. There is a \$20 enrollment fee. We offer AM or PM classes. You must attend an orientation to enroll in GED classes. If you are driving - we also charge a \$10 parking tag fee.

Practice Tests – Pre-registration

Practice tests can be taken for a \$20.00 fee, cash, the correct change. You must come in the office to pre-register & pre-pay the \$20.00 fee. At that time you will be given a date to return for the practice test. Practice tests are scheduled two times per month. We provide morning and afternoon sessions. Tests are graded here at Central Nine and a score report will be sent to your home address.
